Subject: Interlocal Agreement with Collier County to Moor City's Fire-Rescue/Police Vessel at Caxambas Park	Department: Community Development

BACKGROUND:

City Council is asked to consider an Inter-Local agreement with Collier County to permit the City's Fire Rescue/Police vessel to be moored at Caxambas Park, which is located at 909 Collier Court.

In 2006, the City Fire Department approached the Collier County Parks and Recreation Department about the possibility of mooring the Fire Rescue/Police vessel at Caxambas Park. There are several benefits regarding this proposal.

- 1) Currently this vessel is moored at one of the Condominium complexes on the southwestern end of the City. The Fire and Police Department believe that mooring this vessel in the Caxambas Park area will provide a safer location for the vessel since the park is only accessible through a locked gate which is open from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm everyday.
- 2) Fire rescue vehicles can be pulled up next to the proposed mooring space which would allow for an easier access to Fire Rescue and Police equipment. It would also provide for a safer and more expedient manner to disembark injured passengers from the vessel to an EMT vehicle.
- 3) Collier County is currently installing a new fuel pumping station at Caxambas Park. Having the City's Fire Rescue/Police vessel located next to a fuel source would significantly reduce the amount of time it currently takes to refuel.

Included for City Council's consideration are a proposed Inter-Local agreement to allow mooring of the City's Fire Rescue/Police vessel to be moored at Caxambas Park and a map showing the location of the proposed mooring site.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Authorize the City Manager to enter into an inter-local agreement with Collier County to permit the mooring of the City's Fire Rescue/Police vessel at Caxambas Park.
