BACKGROUND:

City Council is asked to consider the appointment of two citizens to fill the expired positions on the Code Enforcement Board.

Chapter 14, Article II of the City Code provides for a seven-member Code Enforcement Board. Members are appointed for a term of three years on a staggered basis. The Code provides that all members of the Board shall be permanent residents and electors of the City and shall serve without compensation.

The Code provides that appointment of members of the Board shall be made on the basis of experience or interest in the fields of zoning and building control or other areas as are relevant to the codes or ordinances of the City to be enforced. The membership of the Board shall, whenever possible, include but not be limited to, an architect, a businessperson, an engineer, a general contractor, a subcontractor, and a realtor.

The terms of office for two appointees, Mr. Jack Patterson (appointed by Councilor Tucker) and Mr. Sal Sciarrino (appointed by Chairman Minozzi) expired on June 1, 2007. Mr. Patterson has resigned from the committee and is not available for reappointment.

Chairman Minozzi recommends the reappointment of Mr. Sal Sciarrino; Councilor Tucker recommends the appointment of Mr. Richard Adams. Mr. Adams resume is attached.
