## **BACKGROUND:**

City Council is asked to consider the award of contract for the construction of the Elkcam Circle Outfall.

The City is replacing approximately 386 linear feet of existing storm sewer that has failed from the east right-of-way line on East Elkcam Circle to the outfall in the Cedar Waterway, along the utility easement between the fire training facility and Cedar Bay Marina. (See attached Site Plan).

The scope of work will include, but is not limited to, pipeline construction, storm structure replacement, bulkhead replacement, construction of temporary cofferdam, maintenance dredging, erosion and pollution control, tree removal, demolition and restoration of pavements, permitting and coordination with other public agencies, contractors, and private property owners.

Traffic impact on East Elkcam Circle will be minimal due to work being completed along the utility easement between the fire training facility and Cedar Bay Marina. Staging of material will be along the right-of-way and along the pipeline. Construction will be completed within 45 days.

Funding for this project is included in the FY07 and FY08 budget.

On October 21, 2007 construction plans were advertised for bids. Bids were opened on November 13, 2007. The results of those bids are as follows:

Following the bid opening, staff recognized an error in the bid schedule. An item in the bid alternate was inadvertently omitted from the base bid. It is recommended that this item, a storm drain vault (\$4,687.50), be added to the base bid award.


The engineer's opinion of cost for this project is \$300,000.

Staff met with the apparent low bidder to review in detail their bid proposal to insure that the bid price submitted by them was appropriate for the work. The apparent low bid contractor is currently working on the island and has the available resources to quickly move onto this project.

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Award of contract to Quality Enterprises USA, Inc. for the construction of Elkcam Circle Outfall Project for a not to exceed amount of \$168,435.00 and authorize the City manager to execute the contract.
