## **BACKGROUND:**

City Council is asked to consider the award of contract for engineering services for Year 3 of the STRP, the Sheffield and Lamplighter Sewer Assessment Areas.

The Septic Tank Replacement Program (STRP) provides for the extension of the central sewer system to serve the unsewered areas of the City. The plan provides for 15 separate assessment districts to be constructed in phases over seven years.

The Septic Tank Replacement Program provides for the creation of two districts in 2007 with construction to begin in April 2008. The two districts are the Lamplighter Area and Sheffield Area. Preliminary Assessment Resolutions to establish each of the two assessment areas will be presented to City Council on February 20th. It is recommended that contracts for engineering design services be authorized in order to ensure construction during the off-season (April – November) in 2008. Design will be completed late in 2007, and contracts for construction will be awarded in early 2008.

On February 7, 2005 City Council approved the selection of Boyle Engineering to provide design services related to the island-wide sewer construction program. Staff has negotiated a scope of services to complete the design for each of the sewer assessment districts and recommends that Boyle Engineering be awarded a not-to-exceed contract for design services as follows:

- ▶ Lamplighter Sewer District      \$235,338
- ▶ Sheffield Sewer District        \$314,829

## **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Authorize the City Manager to enter into contracts with Boyle Engineering for design services for each of the Lamplighter Assessment Area and the Sheffield Assessment Area.
