BACKGROUND:

All advisory committee and Planning Board members serve two-year terms, beginning in June following a City election, and ending two years later in June. Code Enforcement Board members serve a term of three years and terms of members are on a staggered basis.

Each committee consists of seven members appointed by City Council. Each Councilor nominates a citizen to serve on a committee. City Council must agree to the recommended appointee by a majority vote. Committee members must be full-time residents and electors of the City. Citizens are selected based upon their professional background and experience, education, interest in the mission of the committee, leadership, and participation in community organizations and activities.


To be considered for appointment, citizens are asked to volunteer their time and service to the community by submitting a letter of interest and a brief resume. Council has authorized the following boards and committees:

- Planning Board;
- Code Enforcement Board (appointments by Councilors Forcht and Popoff)
- Beautification Advisory Committee;
- Waterways Advisory Committee;
- Beach Advisory Committee
- Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee;
- Arts Advisory Committee.


The staff liaisons to the committees will poll current board and committee members to determine their willingness to serve another term. With Council's approval, staff will also advertise the vacancies to solicit interest from citizens willing to serve their community. Appointments will be scheduled for consideration in May.
