Subject: Award of Contract – Bald Eagle Storm Sewer Addition	Department: Public Works

BACKGROUND:

City Council is asked to consider an award of contract for the construction of the North Bald Eagle storm sewer addition.

The North Bald Eagle storm sewer is being constructed to eliminate the flooding that occurs in the project area and to alleviate the traffic and pedestrian safety concerns in this area. The major components of the project consists of approximately 710 linear feet of new storm sewer, storm structure and bulkhead replacement. Construction of the pipe will be in the swale and the right-of-way will be used to stage equipment and material.

This project (RFB No 08-014) was advertised on December 27, 2007 and bids were opened February 20, 2008. The City received 10 bids listed as follows:




Based on review of the proposals, Staff recommends that a contract award be awarded to Stahlman-England who is the most responsive and lowest bidder. Upon award of contract, Staff will be submitting this project for a SFWMD grant.

The engineer's opinion of cost for this project is \$250,000. Funding for this project is in the current Public Works FY08 CIP budget.

Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract with Stahlman-England to construct the Bald Eagle Storm Sewer Addition for a sum of \$143,583.18
