BACKGROUND: The City is honored to recognize, reward, and celebrate the valuable contributions of its outstanding employees. The outstanding employee for the month of January is Bob Devlin.

As Zoning Administrator and Flood Plain Coordinator, Bob has been a most valuable member of the City's Community Development Department since 2004. Bob continues to work diligently toward improvement of the City's Community Rating System through community flood plain management practices that exceed the minimum National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements.
