Subject: Resolution to Approve a Local Agency Program Supplemental Agreement with FDOT for the Traffic Control Devices Citywide Project.	Department: Public Works

BACKGROUND:

City Council is asked to adopt a resolution and execute a Local Agency Program (LAP) Supplemental Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the project of Traffic Control Devices Citywide at various locations. The Supplemental Agreement amends the Project Locations (Adding North Collier Boulevard and West Elkcam Circle). The Supplemental Agreement also replaces the current Project Description with a more detailed description of the scope of work of this project.

The City was awarded a Local Agency Program Grant from the Florida Department of Transportation to fund the Traffic Control Devices Citywide project. Funding from The Florida Department of Transportation to construct this project is \$203,765. On May 2, 2005 City Council adopted a resolution to execute a Local Agency Program (LAP) Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the project of Traffic Control Devices Citywide at various locations.

The updated Project Location is as follows: "SR 951/N. Barfield Drive, SR 951/East Elkcam Circle, SR 951/Bald Eagle Drive, SR 951/West Elkcam Circle, Bald Eagle Drive/Elkcam Circle, SR 951/San Marco Road, San Marco Road/Heathwood Drive, and San Marco Road/North Barfield Drive".

The updated Project Description is as follows: "To install infrared traffic signal emergency preemption devices at eight (8) intersections within the City of Marco Island, and to provide and install thirty-four (34) emitters and switches in Fire Department and Police vehicles".

Attached is the agreement with Florida Department of Transportation for this improvement and the resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute this Florida Department of Transportation Agreement.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Adopt the resolution and authorize the City Manager to execute the Traffic Control Devices Local Agency Program Supplemental Agreement with Florida Department of Transportation.
