Subject: New Site Permit procedure effective April 1, 2009.

Commercial site work requires a permit by the Building Division for work on the property and a permit by the Public Works Department for work in the right-of-way. The Building Division permits all commercial site work including re-striping of parking lots. Landscaping of existing properties does not require a permit but minimum landscaping requirements, and requirements set during the initial site development plan approval, must be maintained.

Single Family site work requirements changed March 1, 2009. With the adoption of the Marco Island Ordinance 09-03 Administrative Construction Code, driveway replacements and modifications to driveways, as well as any other non-pervious site work on single family properties, now requires a building permit.

Site work permit fees:

- a) Non-pervious site work, storm-water grading, and landscaping during new construction, \$0.02 per square foot of work area, minimum fee \$50.00.
- b) Driveway replacements and modifications \$100.00 flat fee.
- c) Surcharge for scanning 5% of the site permit fee, minimum \$5.00, maximum \$300.00.

Right-of-Way Permit Fees:

- a) New driveway, driveway modification or driveway replacement: \$75.00.
- b) There is no separate plan review fee for the right-of-way permit.
- c) Other right-of-way fees per Public Works Fee Schedule.

Plan review fees are due upon permit submittal. The plan submittal requirements are shown on the site permit application and right-of-way permit application, which are included with this letter.
