Ask to see their STATE-ISSUED OR COUNTY ISSUED license.


Contractors often require years of training, learning, and apprenticeship to obtain their license. Good contractors are always proud to show this achievement.

Contractors include but may not be limited to:

General/Building/Residential, Air-Conditioning Class A/B/C, Journeyman Air Conditioning, Electrical, Journeyman Electrical, Mechanical. Plumbing, Journeyman Plumbing, Roofing, Sheet Metal, Swimming Pool-Spa Commercial/Residential/Servicing.

Specialty trades include: Acoustical, Aluminum, Aluminum Including Concrete, Alarm Contractor I (Burglar & Fire), Alarm Contractor II (Burglar), Cabinet Installation, Carpentry, Commercial Cooling Equipment, Concrete Placing & Finishing, Concrete Forming & Placing, Concrete Contractor Restricted Pneumatically Placed, Decorative Metal, Demolition (Wrecking), Dredging Contractor, Drywall, Elevator, Epoxy Stone, Excavation Contractor, Fence Erection, Fire Protection System Contractor, Floor Coverings, Garage Doors Restricted, Gasoline Tank & Pump, Glass & Glazing, Insulation All Types, Insulation Building, Irrigation Sprinkler, Landscaping, Liquified Petroleum Gas, Marine Sea Walls & Docks, Masonry, Mobile Home Set Up, Tie Down, Painting, Paving Unlimited, Plastering & Stucco, Pollutant Storage Contractor, Reinforcing Steel, Roof Coating, Painting or Pressure Cleaning, Sandblasting, Satellite Dish Installation, Sealing & Stripping, Septic Tank, Sign Contractor Non-Electric, Solar Heater Installation, Structural Steel Erection, Structure Moving, Tile & Marble, Tile, Marble & Terrazzo, Tree Removal & Trimming, Underground Utility Contractor, Well Drilling







WARNING

House Bill 735, a deregulatory bill from the state EFFECTIVE JULY 1st, 2023, preempts local jurisdictions from having <u>certain specialty</u> trade. This means all specialty trade that currently qualifies for local assistance/complaint resolution shall no longer fall under the Collier County Board and any issue may result in consultation from an attorney as being your only recourse or source for remedy.




State and local business registration are often used as a ploy to smokescreen fraudulent action, resulting in loss of property, monies, and your time.


Handymen in Collier County SHALL be limited to: Assemble Exercise Equipment, Assemble Toys, Assemble Furniture, Assemble Gas Grills, Change Light Bulbs, Clean & Change Ceiling Fan Blades, Clean Garages, Clean Gutters, Edge Lawns, Hang Pictures, Haul Trash to Dump, Install Garage Organizers, Move Furniture, Mow Lawn, Pressure Clean Driveways and Walkways (no Roofs), Rake Leaves, Repair Screens, Replace Air Filters, Replace caulking, Replace Door Handles, Wash Windows, Residential/Commercial Cleaning, & Construction Cleaning.
