On Wednesday 4/29/20, the Marco Island City Council voted to open the pedestrian access to public beaches on Thursday morning, 4/30/20. This is coincident with Collier County opening their beaches at Tigertail and South Beach, including parking lots on 4/30/20. The beach and fishing areas at the base of the Jolley Bridge will also open on 4/30/20.

The courts and fields at Mackle Park and the Racquet Center will open on 5/1/20. The buildings at Mackle Park and the Racquet Center will remain closed. The playground, spray park, and restrooms at Mackle Park will remain closed at this time.

All persons utilizing the parks and beaches are required to maintain social distancing and avoid congregating in groups in accordance with CDC guidelines.

The City anticipates further guidance from Governor DeSantis regarding additional openings that may impact Marco Island businesses and residents.
