Executive Order 20-112 issued by Governor DeSantis, takes effect Monday, May 4, 2020 at 12:01 a.m. and lasts until the Governor issues a subsequent order.

- Those at risk (senior citizens and those with significant medical conditions) are strongly encouraged to stay at home.
- The wearing of masks is not mandated.
- You do not need a special permit to leave your home to participate in an essential service or essential activity.
- You should continue to follow safety guidelines issued by the Center for Disease Control.

TRAVEL SCREENING, ISOLATION & QUARANTINE

Executive Order 20-112 extends Airport Screening and Isolation (E.O. 20-80), and the mandatory quarantine (14 days) of individuals traveling to Florida (E.O. 20-82).

BUSINESS CONSIDERATIONS

- The prohibition on vacation rentals remains in effect (E.O. 20-87).
- Bars, nightclubs, fitness centers/ gyms, barbershops and salons will remain closed.
- Businesses are encouraged to provide delivery or pickup and to take orders online or by telephone.
- Restaurants will be allowed to re-open with indoor seating at 25% of building occupancy. Outdoor seating is permissible with appropriate social distancing and seating of parties of 10 or fewer people.
 - Outdoor seating shall not exceed that which was previously approved by the City of Marco Island.
- In store retail sales may open storefronts if operated at 25% building occupancy and abide by Center for Disease Control safety guidelines.
 - Temporary signs (snipe signs, A frames, etc.) which violate city ordinance are required to be removed.

While we are confident the community will voluntarily comply with all executive orders and requirements, we must remind you enforcement penalties remain in place including a fine up to \$500 and imprisonment up to 60 days, or both. Certain regulated businesses may face additional enforcement actions for violations from their regulatory agencies.

- Continue to adhere to all Center for Disease Control and health official guidelines.
- Use social distancing.
- Exercise personal responsibility
- Look out for your neighbors
