Dear Melissa Shirah,

On October 1, 2022, the State of Florida's requested Clean and Sanitize Assistance (CSA) for qualifying Individual Assistance recipients in FEMA-DR-4673-FL. Based on the Regional Administrator's delegation of authority to me, I am approving your request.

As you recognized in your attached request, in addition to meeting general conditions of eligibility (see IAPPG, Chapter 3, Section II), applicants must meet the following conditions in order to receive CSA:

1. The pre-disaster primary residence is in an area designated for Individual Assistance.
2. Based on a FEMA inspection, the applicant has disaster damage recorded or, for renters, noted clean-up actions are needed or have been taken.
3. The damage is not covered by the applicant's insurance.
4. FEMA determines the applicant's disaster-damaged primary residence is safe to occupy.

As you also noted, CSA is limited to \$300 per eligible household and CSA will be awarded as a one-time payment.
