Naples, Fla. — The Florida Department of Health in Collier County (DOH-Collier) encourages those who are eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine to do so.

Vaccine administration is an ongoing effort and receiving the COVID-19 vaccine is an important part in disrupting the spread, preventing COVID-19, and, ultimately, allowing all residents to return to normal.
