Please find Marco Island's Top Ten for May:

- 1. DO YOUR PART TO KEEP OUR BEACHES DARK.** The Marco Island Beach is an important nesting habitat for the Loggerhead Sea Turtle. Sea Turtle Nesting Season is May 1 – October 31. Adult and Hatchling turtles will get disoriented due to artificial lights. No flashlights or flash photography after 9 p.m. All beachside lights should be off or shielded by 9 p.m. DO NOT interfere with turtles, eggs or nests.
- 2. Extended for one more week!** – the last **Farmers' Market** of the season will take place at Veterans' Community Park on May 1 from 7:30 a.m. – 1 p.m.
- 3. May is Drowning Prevention Month.** The life jacket loaner program with loner stations located at beaches in Marco Island is sponsored by the NCH Safe & Health Children Coalition of Collier County.
- 4. Keep our Beaches Beautiful** – The Marco Island Area Board of Realtors is sponsoring a beach clean-up on May 4th at 8 a.m. at the South Beach Boardwalk.
- Join the City Council in welcoming the candidates for the position of City Manager. The **Meet & Greet** will be held at the Marco Island Yacht Club, 1400 N. Collier Boulevard on May 5 from 4-6 p.m.
