- 1. FIREWORKS IN NEIGHBORHOODS ARE PROHIBITED. In Florida, the only legal fireworks for use by consumers (wo do not possess a special permit) are the firework types that are known as "sparklers" including Sparklers, Fountains, Snakes and Glow Worms. If it explodes or is fired in the air it is illegal unless specifically permitted by the City.
- 2. **Do you have problems with a contractor or questions about contractor licensing?** Mr. Joe Nourse, Collier County Licensing Compliance Officer, will be at City Hall every Tuesday from 10 a.m. to Noon and every Thursday from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. No appointment needed.
