7. Approximately 3,800 injured, sick and orphaned native animals are admitted to the **von Arx Wildlife Hospital** each year. Most of those injuries stem from interactions that involve humans – including car strikes, domestic pet attacks, window collisions, fishing line and hook injuries. To report an injured animal, please contact von Arx Wildlife Hospital (Conservancy of Southwest Florida) at 239-262-2273.
8. For any city code violation, including overgrown vegetation and overnight parking in the swales, please contact **Marco Island Code Enforcement** at 239-389-5060.
