- 1. Lane Closure Expect delays leaving the island for a 6-week period, beginning on Sept 9. Portions of one north bound land will be closed on North Collier Blvd. from the Jolley Bridge to Yellowbird St. Both southbound lanes and one northbound lane will remain open. Use SR92 as an alternate route to leave the island during heavy traffic flow times 3-6 p.m.
