The City of Marco Island Water Sewer Department responded to a wastewater spill today in the area of Bald Eagle Drive and Pier 81. The spill is estimated to be 27,000 gallons from a one-inch hole in a four-inch force main. There is a stormwater outfall in the vicinity of the spill and water samples have been taken to ensure public health and safety.

At this time, the site of the spill has been cleaned and disinfected, and there is no danger to the public. The site has been inspected by Collier County Pollution Control. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection has also been notified. The affected section of the force main has been bypassed and City staff are planning the appropriate repair.
