RESOLUTION NO. 98-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND TERMINATING THE FOLLOWING COLLIER COUNTY MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNITS: MARCO ISLAND STREET LIGHTING MSTU (FUND 775), MARCO ISLAND BEAUTIFICATION MSTU (FUND 131), MARCO ISLAND BEACH RENOURISHMENT AND PUBLIC ACCESS MSTU (FUND 159) AND MARCO ISLAND BEACHFRONT RENOURISHMENT FACILITIES MSTU (FUND 318); PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island Charter provides, in Section 10.06(1) and (2), that the City Council may terminate any Collier County Municipal Service Taxing Unit operating within the jurisdiction of the City of Marco Island; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Marco Island wishes to formally evidence the termination of certain Municipal Service Taxing Units within the corporate limits of the City of Marco Island;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the Marco Island City Charter, Section 10.06(1) and (2), the Marco Island City Council does hereby terminate the following four Collier County Municipal Service Taxing Units and the services provided by Collier County through such Municipal Service Taxing Units:

- 1. Marco Island Street Lighting MSTU (County Fund 775);
- 2. Marco Island Beautification MSTU (County Fund 131);
- 3. Marco Island Beach Renourishment and Public Access MSTU (County Fund 159); and
- 4. Marco Island Beachfront Renourishment Facilities MSTU (County Fund 318).

SECTION 2. The termination of the Municipal Service Taxing Units as described in Section 1 shall be effective immediately upon the adoption of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. It is hereby requested and directed that Collier County provide and transfer all remaining funds, contracts, evidences of debt, or other documents, or copies thereof, relevant or material to the operation of the Municipal Service Taxing Units or the services provided thereby, together with all physical assets, if any, of the Municipal Service Taxing Units.

THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
