WHEREAS, the Marco Island Chamber of Commerce has urged Sprint to advance the schedule to upgrade the switching systems servicing Marco Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Marco Island joins with the Marco Island Chamber of Commerce in requesting that Sprint advance its schedule to upgrade the switching systems servicing Marco Island.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Sprint consider rearranging its priorities by providing to the residents and businesses of Marco Island the most advanced communications systems available.
