RELATING TO PETITION NUMBER FV-9901 FOR A VARIANCE FROM THE FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS ON PROPERTY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED IN CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Marco Island City Council, being the duly constituted Board of Appeals for the area hereby affected, has held a public hearing after proper notice as provided in said Regulations was made, and has considered the advisability of granting a variance from the floodproofing requirement to allow for the construction of a wet-floodproofed restroom facility at the South Beach Access Parking Lot; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida, that:

The petition filed by Lynn Bradeen, representing the Marco Island Civic Association, with respect to the property hereinafter described as:

Marco Beach Unit 10, Block 340, Lot 1; Collier County, Florida, and within the City of Marco Island

Be and the same is hereby approved for a variance from the floodproofing requirement to allow for the construction of a wet-floodproofed restroom facility subject to the condition that openings in each enclosed area be located on two different walls where possible. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution relating to Petition Number FV-9901 be recorded in the minutes of this Board and filed with the City Clerk's Office.
