

RESOLUTION NO. 00- 04

A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THAT THE BOARD OF COLLIER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPOINT A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE MARCO ISLAND CITY COUNCIL TO SERVE ON THE TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, Section 125.0104, Florida Statutes, establishes the procedure for the collection and use of the tourist development tax; and

WHEREAS, Section 125.0104(n)(4)(e), Florida Statutes, requires that the governing board of each county, which levies and imposes a tourist development tax, shall appoint a Tourist Development Council consisting of a minimum of nine members; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-987 of the Collier County Code of Ordinances establishes the county Tourist Development Council consistent with Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the composition of the Tourist Development Council shall include two elected municipal officials, at least one of whom shall be from the most populous municipality in the county; and

WHEREAS, the term of office of the elected municipal official from the City of Everglades City will expire as of April 21, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is required to appoint an elected municipal official to serve on the Tourist Development Council for a four-year term thereafter, and

WHEREAS, approximately thirty percent of the tourist development tax is generated from within the corporate limits of Marco Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Marco Island, Florida, that the Board of Collier County Commissioners is respectfully requested to appoint one member of the Marco Island City Council to serve a four-year term on the Tourist Development Council.

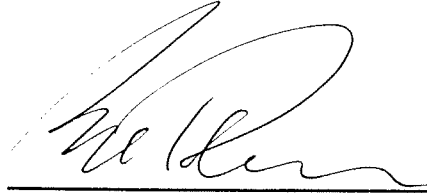
This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Council of Marco Island.
