

RESOLUTION NO. 00- 39

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT FOR HIGHWAY SWEEPING OF S.R. 951 BY THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Marco Island City Council desires to enhance the appearance of S.R. 951 (North Collier Boulevard) between C.R. 92 (San Marco Road) and the northerly approach to the Judge SS Jolley Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Marco Island City Council, after discussion with the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), proposes to perform street sweeping of said segment of S.R. 951 including the SS Jolley Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the FDOT has agreed to provide funds in the amount of \$1,344 per quarter for a total sum of \$5,376 per year for a period of three (3) years for the City of Marco Island to sweep said roadway pavement; and

WHEREAS, the Marco Island City Council believes such obligations through execution of a Maintenance Agreement are in the best interest of the citizens of Marco Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA THAT:


SECTION 1: The City Council of Marco Island, Florida, does hereby authorize its Chairman to execute an Agreement entitled, "State of Florida Department of Transportation Maintenance Agreement" between the City of Marco Island and the FDOT, thereby agreeing to sweep S.R. 951 pavement and the Judge SS Jolley Bridge described in said Agreement in exchange for the payment of \$5,376 per year payable at the rate of \$1,344 per quarter, for a period of three (3) years.


SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3: All Resolutions and parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed.


