

RESOLUTION NO. 01- 05

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE COLLIER COUNTY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S STATE INFRASTRUCTURE BANK APPLICATION TO FUND THE I-75 GOLDEN GATE PARKWAY INTERCHANGE.

WHEREAS, the Collier County Metropolitan Planning Organization has granted approval for the submittal of a State Infrastructure Bank application in order to fund the construction of the I-75/Golden Gate Parkway Interchange; and

WHEREAS, SIB approval of the application will release funds previously designated for the I-75/Golden Gate Parkway Interchange; and

WHEREAS, use of these funds may advance the construction of the second span of the Judge Jolley Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Marco Island City Council has previously endorsed the construction of the Judge Jolley Bridge and the advancement of the bridge to the highest priority; and


WHEREAS, approval of the SIB application may advance the construction to FY2003/04.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA that City Council supports the SIB application to provide funding for the I-75/Golden Gate Parkway Interchange.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that City Council endorses the deferral of the design phase of the Judge Jolley Bridge from FY2002/03 to allow for a design-build project in FY2003/04, utilizing funds previously designated for the I-75/Golden Gate Parkway Interchange.
