

RESOLUTION 18-70

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, EXTENDING THE TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING REGULATIONS FOR SWALES ADJACENT TO COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS AND ALLEYS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, due to the lack of legal parking options for patrons of commercial businesses, City Council has determined it is in the best interest of the public to establish a temporary moratorium on the enforcement of vehicles parking in swales and alleys between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and midnight; and

WHEREAS, the temporary moratorium would only be applicable to swales adjacent to commercially zoned districts; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2017, City Council adopted Resolutions 17-15 and 17-16 which provided a temporary moratorium through November 17, 2017; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2018, City Council adopted Resolutions 18-01 and 18-02 which extended the temporary moratorium through September 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to extend the temporary moratorium on the enforcement of parking regulations for swales adjacent to commercial districts and alleys; and

WHEREAS, City Council does hereby find that the approval of this Resolution is in the best interest of the City of Marco Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The Marco Island City Council approves the temporary moratorium on the enforcement of parking regulations for vehicles parking in swales adjacent to commercial districts and alleys between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and midnight.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
