

ORDINANCE NO. 13-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA AMENDING, RESTATING AND SUPERSEDING THE UTILITY RATE SCHEDULE ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT "A" TO CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2003-19; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island, Florida (the "City"), pursuant to City Ordinance No. 2003-19 (as amended and supplemented from time to time and including any City resolutions related thereto or adopted thereunder, the "Rate Ordinance"), has established rates, fees, and charges for the operations of the water and wastewater utility system owned by the City and providing service within the City of Marco Island and the City's urban service area (the "Utility System"); and

WHEREAS, the revenues generated by the rates, fees and charges of the Utility System are an integral and substantial component of the City's budget and its financial planning each fiscal year, and the appropriation of moneys raised through the rates, fees and charges contemplated hereunder is essential not only for the ongoing administration and operation of the Utility System (including associated supplies, equipment and personnel costs), but also for the funding and financing of capital improvements necessary to ensure the functionality, reliability and longevity of the Utility System and capital programs associated with the City's five year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP"); and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2003-19 provides that rates, fees, and charges of the Utility System shall be reviewed and adjusted as necessary or appropriate; and

WHEREAS, during its regular meeting of August 19, 2013, City Council adopted Resolution No. 13-16 which (i) ratified and confirmed City Council's acceptance and approval of the rate recommendations for the Utility System prepared by Public Resource Management Group (the "Rate Consultant") which included increases for both the annual rate adjustment authorized by Section 52-38 of the City's Code of Ordinances and additional rate adjustments necessary to satisfy expected debt service requirements associated with issuance of the City's not to exceed \$69,000,000 City of Marco Island, Florida Utility System Refunding Revenue Bonds, Series 2013 (the "Series 2013 Bonds"), and (ii) expressed City Council's intent to consider the rate increase recommendations of the Rate Consultant at a duly noticed public hearing; and

WHEREAS, such rate recommendations included a total combined rate increase of 7.00% for the Fiscal Year 2014 to be rendered effective October 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, during its regular meetings held on September 16, 2013 and October 7, 2013, City Council conducted public hearings to consider the Rate Consultant's Utility System rate increase recommendations for Fiscal Year 2014 which are necessary to meet capital improvement needs as identified in the CIP and for the

operation and maintenance of the Utility System and to satisfy debt service requirements for the Series 2013 Bonds and other planned indebtedness; and

WHEREAS, advance written notice of such public hearings was given through the utility system billing process in accordance with Section 180.136, Florida Statutes, and the comments and concerns of all interested parties have been heard and considered by City Council; and

WHEREAS, City Council now wishes to formally adopt the recommended 7.00% combined rate increase for Fiscal Year 2014 by amending, restating and superseding the Utility Rate Schedule attached as Exhibit "A" of the Rate Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals to this Ordinance set forth above are adopted as the legislative findings of the City Council and incorporated as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Rates, Fees and Charges. The Utility Rate Schedule set forth as Exhibit "A" of the Rate Ordinance is hereby amended, restated and superseded by Exhibit "A" attached hereto which is incorporated as though fully set forth herein. Such Utility Rate Schedule shall become effective with bills rendered on and after October 31, 2013.

Section 3. Repeal of Inconsistent Documents. All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby superseded and repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Repeal of Section 52-38. Section 52-38 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marco Island, Florida, is hereby repealed.

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Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.

NOTE 1: Reclaimed water is priced at 40% of Potable Water rate (\$4.12 per 1,000 gallons times 40% = \$1.65) for all customers with the exception of customers with properly permitted privately-owned retention lakes or holding tanks that will accept Reclaimed Water at Utility's request. Reclaimed water fees for those accounts are priced at 30% of Potable Water rate \$4.12 or (\$1.24 per 1,000 gallons).

NOTE 2: Effective October 1, 2007, all new customers connected to the Reclaimed Water system will be charged the current rate in effect for potable water for twenty-four (24) months, to provide for recovery of capital investment costs of expanding the Reclaimed Water distribution system.
