RESOLUTION 19-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, APPROVING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR IGUANA TRAPPING SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000 FOR THE REMAINDER OF FY 2019 BY USING GENERAL FUND CONTINGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in FY 2019 the City of Marco Island City Council appropriated \$5,000 for iguana trapping services and those funds were exhausted in the first quarter of FY 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island desires to continue providing Iguana trapping services for the benefit of its residents for the remainder of FY 2019; and

WHEREAS, the total amount necessary for the remaining three quarters of FY 2019 is \$15,000; and

WHEREAS, these additional funds are available in the City's general fund contingency account; and

WHEREAS, City Council does hereby find that the approval of this Resolution is in the best interest of the City of Marco Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Marco Island hereby appropriates \$15,000.00 for Iguana trapping services for the remainder of FY 2019 and approves the transfer and use of these funds from the City's general fund contingency account. The City Manager is authorized to take the necessary actions to provide these specified services.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
