A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE TOP RANKED FIRM, BSSW ARCHITECT, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$350,000 FOR PHASE 1 ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN SERVICES FOR A NEW FIRE STATION 50. AND CONTINUITY OF **OPERATIONS** CENTER. ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES, AS THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT MANAGER REPRESENTATIVE FOR PHASE II, FOR A FEE OF 90% OF 7.53% OF THE CONSTRUCTION **ACCORDANCE** COST IN WITH RESOLUTION 19-10: AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Florida Statutes, Chapter 287.055, Consultants Competitive Negotiations Act, the City of Marco Island (the "City") published a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for Florida certified, licensed, and experienced architectural firms to provide architectural design services for a new Fire Station 50, and Continuity of Operations Center; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the City's Purchasing Code, Section 2-263, the City Manager established a five-person Scoring Committee to review, evaluate, and rank qualifications packages in accordance with RFQ criteria; and

WHEREAS, on February,4, 2019, City Council passed Resolution 19-10 approving the ranking and recommendations of the Scoring Committee and authorizing the City Manager to negotiate a contract with the highest ranked firm, BSSW Architects, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that contracting with the top ranked firm of BSSW Architects Inc. for the architectural design of a new Station 50 and other services is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with the top ranked firm, BSSW Architects Inc., in a not to exceed amount of \$350,000 for Phase I preliminary architectural design services for a new Fire Station 50 and Continuity of Operations Center; and Phase II, preparation of architectural and engineering construction drawings together with service as the construction project manager representative for the City, for a fee of 90% of 7.53% of construction cost.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
