

**RESOLUTION 19-27**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE STATE OF FLORIDA HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT FOR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS / WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION TO THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Marco Island is the lead agency for the Collier County Regional Hazardous Materials Team; and

**WHEREAS**, the State makes funds available for training and equipment sustainment each year; and

**WHEREAS**, the State has made available \$28,450 for FY2020; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds assist and enable the team to continue to provide local and regional service for hazardous materials; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that accepting the State of Florida Homeland Security Grant for Hazardous Materials/Weapons of Mass Destruction is in the best interest of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

**SECTION 1:** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2:** City Council accepts the 2018 State of Florida Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$28,450.

**SECTION 3:** That the City Manager is authorized to execute and expend the 2018 State of Florida Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$28,450 with the State of Florida Department of Emergency Management.

**SECTION 4:** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
