# **RESOLUTION 20-12**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA AMENDING EXHIBIT "A", UTILITY RATE SCHEDULE, TO ORDINANCE 2003-19; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City of Marco Island, Florida (the "City") pursuant to Ordinance 2003-19 has established rates, fees, and charges for the operations of the water and wastewater utility within the City of Marco Island and the urban service area; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3. of Ordinance 2003-19 provides that rates, fees, and charges shall be reviewed and adjusted; and

WHEREAS, the surcharge to service the debt incurred to increase the Utility Plant capacity caused by the Septic Tank Replacement Program (STRP) Districts is scheduled to decrease from the current 2% to 0% on October 1, 2020.

**WHEREAS**, the surcharge bond sinking fund has accumulated sufficient funds to totally eliminate the surcharge as of May 1, 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida:

**Section 1.** Rates, Fees, and Charges. That Exhibit "A" – Utility Rate Schedule, attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect as of May 1, 2020.

## 6. Water Rate Surcharge:

3 Septic Tank Replacement Program (STNP): AN ADDITIONAL TWO PERCENT 12%; SURCHARGE IS LEVIED ON M.L. CHARGES LISTED IN SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 5 INCLUDING ALL SASE AND CALLOHAGE CHARGES SECLUDING 30 TO OFFICE COSTS OF SUTTLE TANK REPLACEMENT MOCION FIRST. A water rate on charge is levied to finance the costs of reducing the neighborhood construction for the GTNP in the amount of \$2,750 per property. Cost reduction is the net present value of payments in monthly sewer user fees for upgrading the existing wastewater utility plant. Water rate surcharge in the amount of two percent (2%) in movement at 3% in October 2007, reduced to 5% on March 2013, reduced to 3% in October 1, 2016, reduced to 5% on November 1, 2017, reduced to 4% on November 1, 2019, and reduced to 2% on November 1, 2019.
