## **RESOLUTION 23-04**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, APPOINTING CARLETON C. EALY AS A TRUSTEE ON THE POLICE OFFICERS' PENSION PLAN BOARD AND ON THE FIREFIGHTERS' PENSION PLAN BOARD

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to FL. Statutes 175.061 and 185.05, and Marco Island Code of Ordinances sections 22-54 and 32-46, membership of the Trustee Boards of the Police Officers' Pension Plan and the Firefighters' Pension Plan shall consist of two legal residents of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, one (1) vacancy currently exists under the resident trustee category on the Police Officers' Pension Plan Board and the Firefighters' Pension Plan Board. Applicant Carleton C. Ealy, a legal resident of Marco Island, possesses experience and qualifications that make him an excellent choice to serve on the Pension Boards.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Marco Island City Council encourages citizens to participate in their government by volunteering to serve on boards and committees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- Section 2. The Marco Island City Council approves the appointment of Carleton C. Ealy as trustee on the Police Officers' Pension Plan Board and on the Firefighters' Pension Plan Board, for a concurrent term of four-years, commencing February 6, 2023.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
