- Volunteers are not to sign out early without permission from Park Management.
- Dress code requirements are as follows: we will provide a LIT t-shirt that must always be worn, closed toed shoes, shorts of appropriate length or pants.
- During your time volunteering, you will contribute in a positive manner, creating a safe, healthy, and welcoming environment for campers.
- Phones are not to be used while signed into your shift. If you are seen with your phone you receive one warning. If you are seen with your phone again it will result in, you been sent home for the day. If the issues continue it will result in discontinuation of volunteering for the remainder of the summer.
- Please show up on time to your scheduled shift. If you are running late or cannot come in, please call Mackle Park staff so they can notify Dawn.
- Schedules will be posted every Wednesday; it is YOUR responsibility to look over the schedule to make sure that you are able to work your assigned shifts. If you are unable to work, YOU must speak with Luca regarding your shifts.
- If you have three or more unexcused absences (NO-SHOWS), it will result in discontinuation of volunteering for the remainder of the summer.
- LIT's are not to handle or hold money for campers. Campers will be responsible for their own money & possessions.
- Being a LIT will not only help you meet your school's community service requirements; it will provide future job experience, by learning valuable life lessons and helping your community.
- Disciplinary action will be taken if policies and procedures cannot be followed.
