## EVENTS

- The Annual Tree Lighting was held at 6pm December 2<sup>nd</sup> at Veteran's Park
- The month started out right when, on December 1, 2017, when Collier County awarded Sgt. James Inlow and Officer Lorenzo Smith with the Phoenix Award (Life Saving Award)
- Marco's Annual Boat Parade, scheduled December 16, was cancelled due to unsafe conditions still remaining in the channels from Hurricane Irma.
- December 15<sup>th</sup>, Coffee & a Bagel with a Cop was held at Empire Bagel. Citizens came in to get to know and to chat with our MIPD Officers.
- Santa arrived at 9:30 December 16<sup>th</sup> and all hands were on deck for the Christmas Parade that evening.

The male resisted the efforts of Officer Hernandez, who was able to maintain a grasp onto Officer Jeff Stafford arrived on scene and assisted pulling the individual over the bridge railing. The uninjured male was taken into protective custody.
