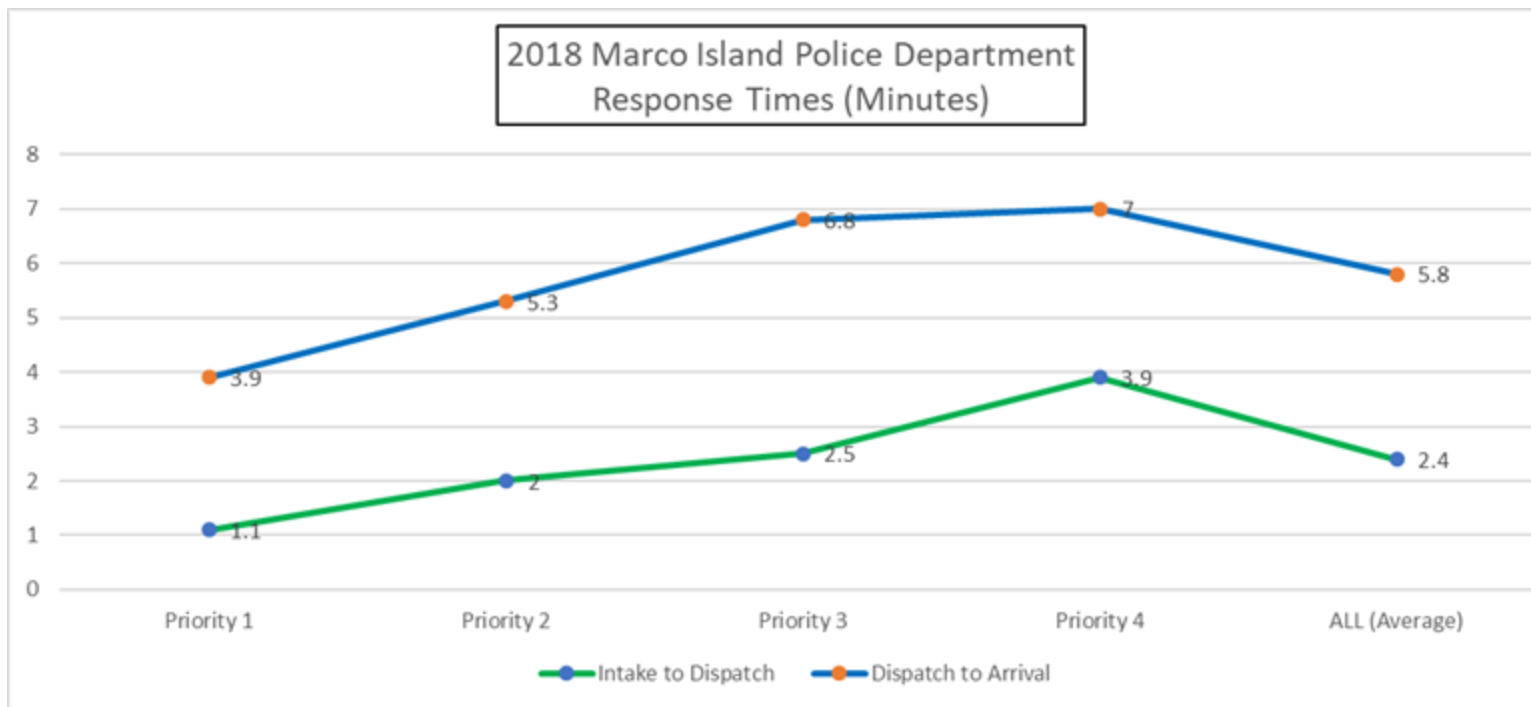

2019 Monthly City Council Report

The Marco Island Police Department has completed its study of response time for all 2018 incidents. The times demonstrated would be considered by many, if not most, public safety and community leaders to be exceptional. While it is common to compare response times from community to community, traditional benchmarking is not considered effective based on a host of demographic, geographic, situational and logistical factors unique to each community. Please note the difference between intake to dispatch and dispatch to arrival times.
