## INTRODUCTION

December began with the decorating of the Christmas Island Style Tree at Veteran’s Community Park where Officer Mitchell Kelley participated in trimming of the tree. Many officers assisted in the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Christmas First Responder Style holiday event at the Island Country Club, handing out gift cards to selected local families. ## Reserve / Auxiliary Program Activity Hours

Reserve and Auxiliary Police Officers are unpaid volunteers who are certified by the State of Florida to perform in the law enforcement role. These officers must meet the Department's and State of Florida's annual retraining / certification requirements. Reserve and Auxiliary personnel are required to volunteer a minimum of 16 hours per month. They perform a variety of functions for our Department and community which are outlined in the chart below. Particularly they assist full-time personnel at community events or special duty functions (requests for an officer to be assigned and compensated by the outside vendor) and during significant weather events such as hurricanes or flooding. Reserve and Auxiliary Officers provide an additional uniformed police presence in neighborhoods, commercial areas, schools, parks, and beaches. Once a month Reserve and Auxiliary Officers have a staff meeting to review policy changes, attend training and address planning and logistical requirements. The below chart signifies the logged hours that have been devoted to the particular assignment by the Reserve and Auxiliary Officers.

# Detective Bureau Monthly Report

## December 2020

### INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

#### Self-Initiated Reports:

**Threat of School Violence** – Detective Bureau took an initial report of possible threat of school violence by a pupil. The statement was evaluated by interviewing numerous witnesses, the pupil, and his father. After a thorough investigation, it was determined that the words spoken did not meet the criteria for a criminal referral. This issue was handled administratively by school officials.

**Assist EMS** – Detective assisted an elderly person who fell from medical scooter. Referred to EMS.

**Burglary** – Report of burglary to a dwelling. No suspects or leads.

#### Cases Closed by Detective Bureau

**Sexual Battery** – After completion and submission of this case to the State Attorney's Office an arrest warrant was issued. Prosecution pending.

**Grand Theft** – Theft of new lights from the front porch of a residence. No suspect information or evidence. The case is inactive.

**Child Neglect** – A child was left alone in a car at a store. After an investigation and DCF referral, a suspect was cited and provided a court date.

**Hit and Run** – A parked vehicle was struck outside a restaurant. After collecting surveillance video and other evidence, the driver could not be identified, and the case is inactive.

**Sexual Battery** – Investigation into a 22-year-old male having sex with a 13-year-old female led to him being charged with sexual battery. Suspect is currently incarcerated at NJC and is awaiting trial.

**Grand Theft/Embezzlement** – Investigation into a woman embezzling money from a doctor's office. Case was suspended due to the doctor's office not wanting to proceed.

**Credit Card Fraud** – A victim had her credit card stolen from her purse while on the beach. Video was recovered of 3 suspects using the victim's credit card. Photographs of the suspects were disseminated to other law enforcement agencies and the public, however no identifications were ever made.

**Forging a Prescription** – Investigation into a woman using her doctor's script pad to write herself a prescription. The doctor's office ultimately stopped cooperating with the investigation and the doctor never signed a statement wishing to press charges.

**Grand Retail Theft** – A suspect was being investigated for stealing high-end wine from a grocery store. After receiving a credible tip, the suspect was identified and arrested. Approximately 90 bottles of wine were recovered by investigating this case.

**Vehicle Burglaries and Auto Thefts** – A string of overnight vehicle burglaries and auto thefts from the end of November were investigated. All the vehicles were left unlocked and the vehicles that were stolen had the keys inside. All the stolen vehicles were recovered and returned to their rightful owners. From the vehicle burglaries, wallets that were taken were later recovered. The remaining items that were taken were not of substantial value. The information gathered lead to the intelligence of the suspects being an organized group from the Saint Petersburg area. At this time, there is not enough evidence to charge a specific person(s).

**Follow-Up Reports from Patrol:**

**Death Investigation** – Decedent died during the night and was discovered by spouse.

**Vandalism** – juvenile suspect broke an electrical outlet at Mackle Park.

**Mentally Disturbed Person** – Detective conducted a threat assessment on an ex-boyfriend’s perceived threatening behavior. Subject has mental health issues and is undergoing in-patient treatment. Complainant is seeking an injunction for protection.

**Death Investigation** – Female subject died in home of natural causes.

**Check Fraud** – Victim was scammed into depositing checks into a suspect’s account, thinking it would free her grandson from jail.

**Petit Theft** – Suspect stole donation money left on the counter at a gas station.

**Defrauding an Innkeeper** – Suspects walked out on their tab at a restaurant. A suspect has been identified and the investigation is ongoing.

**Threats** – Unknown suspect making threats using an unknown electronic device. Case is ongoing.

**Aggravated Battery** – Suspect struck a pedestrian after fleeing from a private property traffic crash. The suspect has been identified and the case is ongoing.

**Overnight Vehicle Burglaries and Auto Thefts** – A string of overnight vehicle burglaries and auto thefts occurred in the middle of December. All the vehicles were left unlocked and the vehicles that were stolen had the keys inside. The cases are open and being investigated.

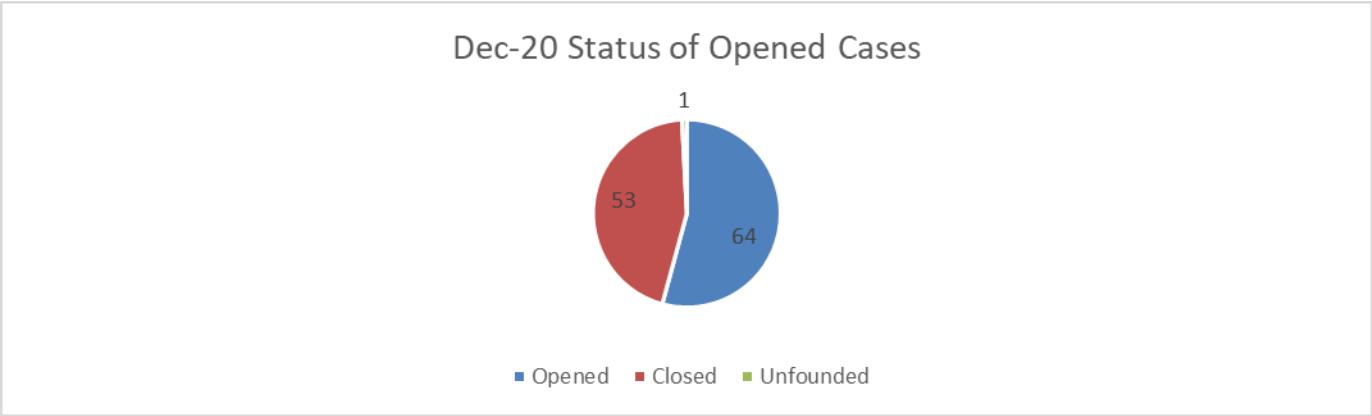
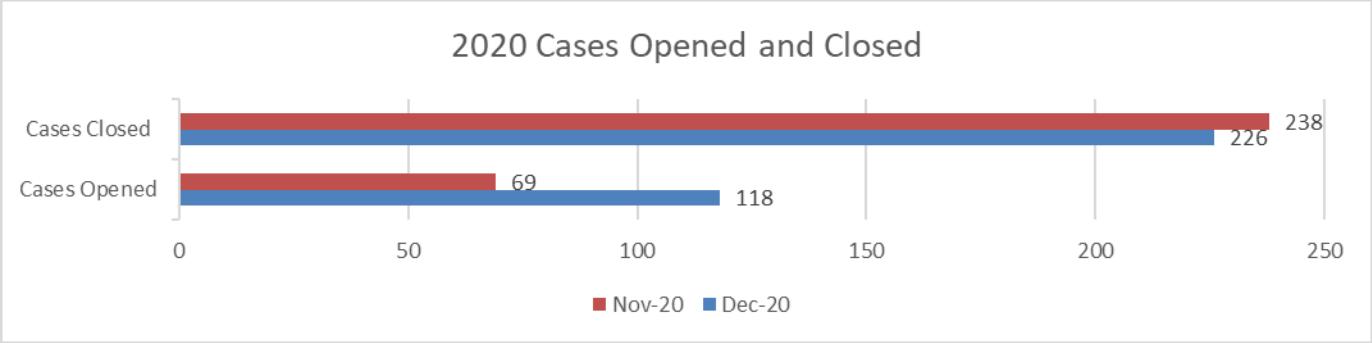
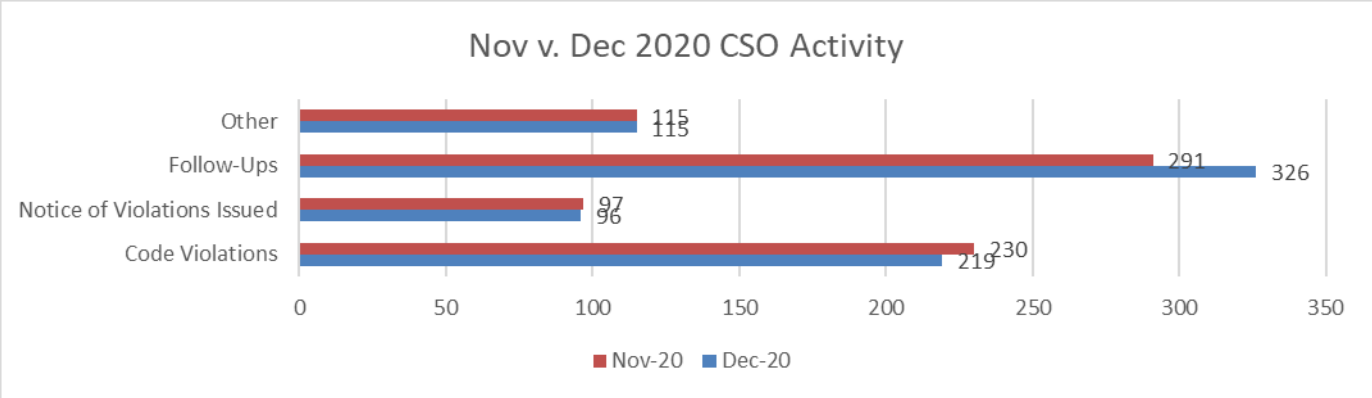
