Re: February 2016 Monthly City Council Report

After reviewing the Marco Island Police Department's Policy and Procedures Manual, I have determined that our current version is outdated and does not reflect current police response protocols. We are fairly certain that we would not currently qualify for Florida accreditation. The 43 policies outlined in our current manual were last reviewed in 2002 through 2004. The Department of Justice recommends that police agencies review their policies and procedures every three years.

Today, more than ever, law enforcement agencies need effective policies and procedures that reflect best practices in the field, legislative changes, protection against litigation, and increased community expectations of ethical and constitutional policing.

I recommend contracting with Transformational Strategies & Solutions (TS&S) to work with us to help develop new policies and procedures from the ground up. TS&S comes highly recommended by other Florida police agencies. The cost will be \$49,800.00, and will be covered utilizing Asset Forfeiture Funds.

Over a years' time, they will assist us in creating a new policy and procedure manual that contains forty (40), and not to exceed sixty (60), new General Orders that will reflect current industry best practices, legal requirements and Florida Standards. This process will also include staff training and strategic planning in order to obtain Florida accreditation.

The Department's part-time CSO's conducted community patrols of the schools, commercial and residential areas, as well as intermittent beach and parks patrols. In February, Community Service and Law Enforcement personnel attended to 223 CAD (Dispatched) events classified as "Code Complaints" at 183 unique addresses. It is important to note that these calls do not include parking or noise related events which are classified as separate categories. In the last six months of 2015, code violation calls averaged approximately 220 events per month and represented numerically, the single largest category of dispatched versus solely self-initiated calls.

Code Advisory Committee Report presented to City Council on 2/2/16:

The Code Advisory Committee Chairman, Mr. Marv Needles, will present the Committee's recommendations regarding changes to Chapter 18, Article II (Nuisance, Litter, Weed, Plant and Right-of-Way Control) of the City's Code of Ordinances.

Included in the recommendations:

- Revise the language under Section 18-36 (Prohibited Activities and Conditions) to allow placement of trash cans at the curb from sunrise the day before pickup through sunset of the day of pickup.
- Consider scheduling an additional day of yard waste pickup (Mondays) to reduce the amount of landscape debris along the roadways. (This would require an amendment to the franchise agreement that Collier County currently has with Waste Management.)
- To reduce violations, send out annual notices in April to vacant lot owners, and monthly notices to new property owners, informing them of their responsibilities.
- Increase the fines for unabated violations from \$100 to \$250, which will fund the proposed recommendation to send out the annual/monthly notices to property owners.
- Omit all Code Enforcement Board references throughout the chapter.
- Consider fining repeat violators without first issuing "warning" notices needs legal review.
