Community Events

02/24/17 Coffee with the Chiefs, a reoccurring public relations event, was held at Wake-up Marco.

Marco Island Police School Resource Officers (SROs) began the Drug Abuse Resistance Education (D.A.R.E.) program at Tommie Barfield Elementary School. Student bicycle safety checks are continuously provided by SROs. Due to the generosity of the Marco Island Knights of Columbus, four helmets were provided to children in need during the month of February.

Investigations
