Investigations

CASE FOLLOW UPS: 85

SIGNIFICANT CASE INFORMATION/INCIDENTS:

- MIPD Officers were dispatched to Mackle Park on a report of four juveniles with alcohol. All four juveniles were trespassed from Mackle Park. Their parents were contacted and subsequently picked up the juveniles.

Subject fit the description of the previous suspect, who later admitted to doing the damage at the Racquet Center. Subject was charged with criminal mischief and transported to Naples Jail Center.
- MIPD Officer conducted a traffic stop on North Collier Blvd. Further investigation revealed one of the occupants was in possession of marijuana. Subject was transported to Naples Jail Center.
- MIPD Officers responded to Marco Island Yacht Club to investigate a report of suspicious persons on a boat. Further investigation revealed four persons attempted to remove the boat from the marina. While doing so, the boat's engine malfunctioned and was inoperable. The operator of the boat was arrested and charged with burglary and grand theft. Subject was transported to Naples Jail Center.

Beach Patrol

Beach patrols have increased 187% from May 2015 to July 2015. In July, there were 155 unique events that included 77 Police or Community Service Officer initiated patrols on the beach or water immediately adjacent to the beach, 61 foot patrols, 8 community events, 1 water rescue and 1 missing person.

Community Service Officers / Code Enforcement

The Department's seven part-time CSO's conducted community patrols of the beach, parks, schools, and commercial and residential areas. We have been enforcing the City code as it pertains to blocking the sidewalk. The Council may wish to consider a modification to prohibit blocking the sidewalk from 6:00 a.m. to 10 p.m. versus 24/7/365. They assisted Law Enforcement personnel, conducted fingerprinting on Tuesdays and Thursdays, oversaw the issuance of RV parking permits, and conducted sea turtle / light inspections and beach law education. They also participated in the following community events: a Bike Safety Event, CCSO Hot Summer Nights at Mackle Park, and the annual Camp Mackle Beach event.

In July, Community Service and Law Enforcement personnel attended to 251 CAD (Dispatched) events classified as "Code Complaints" at 207 unique addresses. CAD events at repeat addresses included follow-up investigations.

Note: Community Service Officers often close cases opened in prior months once compliance has been obtained.

The Department received twenty-nine (29) noise-related complaints in July, with only eight occurring during regular CSO working hours. Twenty-two (22) of these events occurred at single family dwellings, 2 in outdoor locations: intersections, construction (vehicle noise), 2 at hotels, 1 at a business, and finally, 2 condo. You will note that verified noise complaints, handled by MIPD Patrol Officers, are automatically followed up with appropriate action by the Code Enforcement Unit. In July, the Code Enforcement Unit sent 14 Courtesy Notices to owners of locations with verified first-time noise violations.

An Acacia tree on 2nd Avenue was determined to be a noxious species by the City's former environmentalist. We are moving forward with a request for voluntary compliance (removal). If this does not occur, the property owner will be brought before the Magistrate. The complainant is aware of same.

Training

- Sgt. Ojanovac attended the FDLE CJIS symposium in Ponte Vedra Beach. Numerous topics relating to the Florida Criminal Justice Information System were discussed at length.
- Officer Mack, Officer Gaskill and Officer C. Smith attended the Florida Firearms Instructor Course at the Southwest Florida Public Service Academy in Ft. Myers. The 80-hour class consisted of both classroom and practical/range time. All three successfully completed the course and are now designated as Agency Firearms Instructors.
- Chief Schettino & Captain Baer attended the City's Hurricane seminar and policy walk-through.
- Captain Baer assisted with EOC staffing, logistics, and training efforts in July.
- Captain Baer attended WEB EOC training at Collier County Emergency Management.
- Multiple Community Service Officers attended post-storm damage assessment training.
- Community Service Officer Mike Pisano completed his basic training in July.
- Several Department staff attended an Emergency Operations Preparedness class at the Fire Dept.
