Re: June 2016 Monthly City Council Report

The Police Department continues to upgrade its patrol fleet. Six 2016 Ford Explorer SUV patrol vehicles delivered on July 27 are in the process of being equipped for police use. These new Explorers will replace six aging vehicles in our current fleet. The Police Marine Unit's Donzi boat is currently being fitted with a new fuel tank. In addition, delivery of the newly-purchased 2016 Ranger boat is expected in two weeks.

Beach Patrol

In June there were 37 unique events that included 22 Police or Community Service Officer initiated patrols on the beach or water immediately adjacent to the beach, as well as 1 missing person, 1 marine emergency and one animal complaint. Dedicated beach activities accounted for 23 team member hours during the month. As previously reported last month, we identified a programming error in the Collier County CAD system that miscoded events that took place on the beach. Thanks to the Collier County Sheriff's Office, the programming error has been corrected. After review we noted, as expected, past activities reported were understated. For example, we previously reported 47 beach events in April 2016, when in actuality the correct number was 82.

After substantial internal discussions between CSO's, Administrative and Command Staff regarding the business processes involved with Courtesy Notices (CN) versus Notice of Violations (NOV) the Department discontinued the use of CN's in favor of the use of NOV's on 6/2/16. We recognized that CN's were a creation of a former Marco Island colleague, and as such, they are not defined nor called for in the Florida Statutes that regulate Code Enforcement. The continued use of CN's did not add sufficient value to offset the administrative, financial and logistical burdens as well as the temporal delay involved in their use.

The Department's Community Service Officers conducted proactive patrols of schools, commercial and residential areas, as well as several community events and intermittent beach & parks patrols. Community Service and Law Enforcement personnel attended to 318 CAD (Dispatched) events classified as "Code Complaints" at 263 unique addresses. It is important to note that these calls do not include parking or noise related events, which are classified as separate categories. In the last six months of 2015, Code Violation calls averaged approximately 220 events per month and represented numerically, the single largest category of dispatched versus solely self-initiated calls.

The next Code Enforcement Magistrate's Hearing is scheduled for September 27, 2016 at 1:00 pm.

Landscape Buffer Violations: After significant investigation, we have determined that 19 Bald Eagle Drive / 1310 San Marco Road was "grandfathered" from the current Landscape Buffer Ordinance. At the most recent Code Enforcement Magistrate's Hearing, the same address was found in violation of several unrelated landscape and screening ordinance violations.

Commercial Land Use and Zoning Certificate (CLUZC): The 2nd set of notification letters were delivered in the last days of June.
