The Department's Community Service Officers conducted proactive patrols of schools, commercial and residential areas, as well as several community events and intermittent beach & parks patrols. Community Service and Law Enforcement personnel attended to 202 CAD (Dispatched) events classified as "Code Complaints" at 165 unique addresses. It is important to note that these calls do not include parking or noise related events, which are classified as separate categories. In the last six months of 2015, Code Violation calls averaged approximately 220 events per month and numerically represented the single largest category of dispatched versus solely self-initiated calls.

Additionally, we have trained two civilian volunteers to assist with Tuesday & Thursday fingerprinting responsibilities to facilitate additional CSO patrols, calls for service and follow-up investigations. All CSO vehicles now have computers installed to enable remote use of CAD and other records management/database systems. Regrettably, one of the three vehicles assigned to CSO personnel suffered a transmission failure and was taken out of service, as the cost to repair was double the residual value of the vehicle (2007 Ford Escape).

Additional signs regarding the requirement of dog leashes and proper dog waste disposal were posted at Mackle Park.

Community Service Officers continue to review all locations identified by the Beautification Committee. Process challenges include the fact that nearly every business contacted claims an exemption or “Grandfather” status, while some have requested a “waiver.” While we are providing educational information, legally we must clarify these issues prior to taking any formal enforcement action. We continue to conduct intensive collaborative reviews (\*) in conjunction with the Collier County Property Appraiser as well as the City of Marco Island Planning / Zoning & Building Departments.

In order to do this, we must identify dates and conditions associated with ownership, change of use, prior Code Enforcement Cases or orders, certification of occupancy, or other permit conditions. This includes reviewing documents from 1998 to present. Of note, most businesses contacted require intensive assistance, as they do not understand the requirements; we have utilized the services of the City’s Environmentalist as well as colleagues from the City of Marco Island Planning / Zoning.
