COVID-19

In March, the Police Department was extensively involved in COVID-19 planning, mitigation, and operations. Education, safety, and logistics were the primary focus areas.

Within the City, the Police Department coordinated our efforts with the City Manager and all other City entities. By doing so, we as the City ensured resources were used efficiently, maintained a unified command structure and provided consistent messaging.

MIPD also partnered with the Department of Health, Collier County Emergency Management, Collier County Sheriff's Office, and dozens of other public safety and business entities. Doing so enabled the Police Department to be aware of current information, trends, and assisted the Department in planning and operations.

To protect the public and organizational resources, the Police Department modified several operational procedures to comply with the Center for Disease Control and Department of Health guidelines. Additionally, we educated the public relative to Florida Executive Orders and other local, state and federal requirements.

Detective Bureau Monthly Report

INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

Self-Initiated Reports:

Sex Offender Check Leland Way – Sex offender was discovered to be visiting at this address. Contact was made and informed him of the Marco Island Sex Offender Ordinance. The case was closed by issuing him a written warning and he vacated the property.

Information Fraud Jamaica Ct – The Pentagon Federal Credit Union called MIPD to inquire about a resident being exploited. Detectives followed-up with the resident and discovered that no exploiting took place. A report was drafted to document the information discovered and the case was closed.

Domestic Aggravated Stalking – Detectives were investigating a no contact order violation from a domestic violence case and were in the process of obtaining a warrant for the suspect. While the warrant was being processed, Detectives heard a call for service from the same victim over the radio and self-initiated a response. The victim alleged that the suspect made 3 additional attempts to contact the victim. Detectives developed probable cause for domestic aggravated stalking and arrested the suspect prior to one of his court hearings.

Information Harassment – A reporting party contacted the Police Department regarding her husband's son harassing them by calling the Police to do welfare checks on them. Contact was made with the parties involved and there was no harassment taking place. The parties have differences from past family disputes. A report was generated by the Detective Bureau to close out the case.

Attempted GTA – Piedmont Ct – In the course of investigating other GTAs and vehicle burglaries in the area. Detective found another victim vehicle. Related to Overnight Auto Thefts and Burglaries on 03/25/2020.

Cases Closed by Detective Bureau

Violation of No Contact Order - Suspect violated a No Contact Order issued by a Judge due to a Domestic Violence incident in the county. This case was closed with an arrest made in the Aggravated Stalking Case mentioned prior.

Assault Nassau Ct – MIPD received a call about a son threatening his mother and her friend who was older than 65. Detectives followed-up with the complaint and established probable cause to arrest him.

Narcotics Nassau Ct – While investigating the suspect in the assault case mentioned above, it was discovered he was also manufacturing marijuana for sale. A search warrant was obtained for the residence and over 75 items were seized in connection to narcotic offenses. The suspect was additionally charged with Manufacturing Marijuana, Felony Drug Paraphernalia, Possession of Marijuana over 20 grams, Possession of Place being Utilized for Manufacturing Controlled Substance with Minor Present, Possession of Controlled Substance (Psilocybin Mushrooms).

Fraud - Driftwood Ct - Gift Card Scam for false computer/internet upgrades. Inactive

Hit & Run - N Collier Blvd – A victim alleged that her vehicle was hit, and the suspect fled the scene. Detectives closed out the case inactive based on no leads to follow-up on.

Overdose Winterberry Dr – Collected video evidence for case file and future inquiry. Case closed

Fraud – N Collier Blvd – Store employees stopped a gift card scam. Detectives determined that phone scam originated outside the USA. Assisted victim in identity theft protocols. Case closed inactive.

Petit Theft – Huron Ct - Bicycle theft report closed out after determining there were no surveillance cameras in the area. Case Inactive.

Roll Over Crash – N. Collier Blvd. - Case files and photo evidence provided to coroner after passenger died at the hospital. Case Closed

Medical Emergency – San Marco Rd - Case files and photo evidence provided to coroner after patient died at the hospital. Case closed

Marine Officers are working with FWCC to have two derelict vessels removed from Factory Bay, however all similar cases are now on hold due to COVID-19.

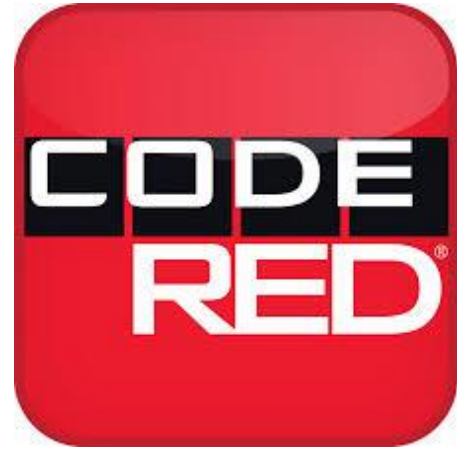
