DATE & TIME: 05/16/2016

INCIDENT: Death Investigation

Officers were dispatched to a residence located in Angler’s Cove in reference to a death investigation. Investigation continues.

INCIDENT: DUI

An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that was speeding. The driver, Raymond Orr Jr., was arrested for DUI and was transported to Naples Jail Center.

DATE & TIME: 05/29/2016

INCIDENT: Driving on Suspended License

An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for an expired tag. The driver, John Gresham, was arrested for Driving with a Suspended License and was transported to Naples Jail Center.

An Officer witnessed a male subject throw a glass bottle at a business. The male subject, Anthony Donato, was arrested for Disorderly Conduct and transported to Naples Jail Center.

Beach Patrol

In May, there were 30 unique events that included 27 Police or Community Service Officer initiated patrols on the beach or water immediately adjacent to the beach. Dedicated beach activities accounted for just over 32 staff hours during the month. Please note, in June we identified a programming error in the Collier County CAD system that miscoded events that took place on the beach. The resultant effect of the error is that not all activities that actually occurred were being attributed to our beach zone, making it appear that less events or time was being spent on the beach. We are working with the Collier County Sheriff's Office to correct this programming error. Once the error is corrected, we will brief you accordingly.

Community Service Officers / Code Enforcement

The Department's Community Service Officers conducted proactive patrols of schools, commercial and residential areas, as well as several community events and intermittent beach & park patrols. Community Service and Law Enforcement personnel attended to 228 CAD (Dispatched) events classified as "Code Complaints" at 187 unique addresses. It is important to note that these calls do not include parking or noise related events which are classified as separate categories. In the last six months of 2015, code violation calls averaged approximately 220 events per month and represented numerically, the single largest category of dispatched versus solely self-initiated calls (Please refer to the code section of monthly report for more details.)
