EVENTS

- Meals of hope was a great success on November 4th. So much so that we ran out of bags to package meals! Chief Schettino and Officers were present to lend a helping hand.
- On November 11th we honored our Veterans with our Marco Island Honor Guard and ceremony.
- On November 14th, Police and Fire Foundations teamed up to hold a fundraiser at San Marco Catholic Church, where everyone enjoyed a spaghetti and meatball dinner.
- The Farmer's Market Started November 15th, with 3 MIPD Officers present, assuring that everyone in attendance was safe and sound.
- In mid-November, the Marco Island Police Department Code Enforcement Unit teamed-up with Florida's Bureau of Compliance / Division of Worker's Compensation, Florida's Fraud & Consumer Protection Investigators, and Collier County Contractor Licensing, for a two-day sweep of Marco Island. Thirty-four sites were visited and over fifty individuals interviewed. Between the agencies represented, fourteen enforcement actions were taken. These included unlicensed contracting, and construction site violations.
- The Thanksgiving Day Parade was on November 24th, and the same day, the Police Department was present for Santa's arrival at 6:00 pm at The Shops of Marco
