# **Reserve / Auxiliary Program Activity Hours**

Reserve and Auxiliary Police Officers are unpaid volunteers who are certified by the State of Florida to perform in the law enforcement role. These officers must meet the Department's and State of Florida's annual retraining / certification requirements. Reserve and Auxiliary personnel are required to volunteer a minimum of 16 hours per month. They perform a variety of functions for our Department and community which are outlined in the chart below. Particularly they assist full-time personnel at community events or special duty functions (requests for an officer to be assigned and compensated by the outside vendor) and during significant weather events such as hurricanes or flooding. Reserve and Auxiliary Officers provide an additional uniformed police presence in neighborhoods, commercial areas, schools, parks, and beaches. Once a month Reserve and Auxiliary Officers have a staff meeting to review policy changes, attend training and address planning and logistical requirements. The below chart signifies the logged hours that have been devoted to the particular assignment by the Reserve and Auxiliary Officers.



# Detective Bureau Monthly Report November 2020

### **INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:**

### Self-Initiated Reports:

**Suspicious Incident** - A report of possible fraud at the City Water & Sewer Department was investigated. It was determined to be a customer's misunderstanding of billing with no fraud occurring.

Sex Crime - An allegation of a sex crime occurring on Marco Island was received after it was reported out of state.

### Cases Closed by Detective Bureau

**Suspicious Person** – A subject who was alleged to be unstable to possess firearms was cleared through court proceedings.

**Assist other Agency** – A Marco Island resident was suspected to be involved in a sex crime in Maryland. That resident was interviewed by MIPD and the findings were reported back to the investigating agency.

### Follow-Up Reports from Patrol:

Assault – Victim was threatened in local liquor store. Suspect not identified, possibly a visitor to the island.

**Baker Act** – Detectives followed up with Dept of Children and Families (DCF) regarding an elderly male in need of services once he is released from treatment. DCF accepted the report.

**Death Investigation** – Employee at a local resort found deceased on the property. Case is awaiting a determination of cause of death from the Medical Examiner's Office.

**Death Investigation** – Female subject located deceased in her condominium with an apparent self-inflicted wound. Case is awaiting a cause of death from the Medical Examiner's Office.

**Death Investigation** – Male subject located deceased in his condominium with an apparent self-inflicted wound. Case is awaiting a cause of death from the Medical Examiner's Office.

**Death Investigation** – Female subject located deceased in her home. Case is awaiting a cause of death from the Medical Examiner's Office.

**Fraud** – Suspect used a stolen credit card to purchase mechanic labor. The suspect has been identified and the case is ongoing.

**Fraud** – Suspect has stolen a large quantity of wine from a retailer over a 4-month period. The suspect has been identified and the case is ongoing.

Fraudulent Prescription – Detective bureau investigating fraudulent prescriptions delivered by FAX. Case is ongoing.

**String of Overnight Vehicle Burglaries** – MIPD confirmed 11 vehicle burglaries and 3 stolen vehicles on 11/29/2020. Several vehicles have been processed for fingerprints and DNA. MIPD is currently working with partner agencies to solve the crimes.

**Risk Protection Order Renewal** – A risk protection order from 2019 was about to expire. Due to continuing mental health issues from the respondent, the city sought to extend the order which was granted through a court approved joint stipulation.

**Violation of Injunction** – Ex-husband is alleged to be contacting ex-wife in violation of an injunction for protection. Case is ongoing.




