## INTRODUCTION

October is nationally recognized as Domestic Violence Awareness Month. Chief Frazzano presented a proclamation on behalf of the City Council, pledging the City of Marco Island's support for The Shelter for Abused Women and Children and recognizing October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month. Marco Island Police Officers worked with local and federal law enforcement agencies in South West Florida to provide dignitary protection for several events. Community Service Officers Joseph Dodd and Chris Citarella assisted Florida Fish and Wildlife in multiple manatee and sea turtle rescues at Tiger Tail Beach. The Marco Island Police Department worked with the community, City staff, and City Council in the study and preparation of a noise ordinance.

## Reserve / Auxiliary Program Activity Hours

Reserve and Auxiliary Police Officers are unpaid volunteers who are certified by the State of Florida to perform in the law enforcement role. These officers must meet the Department's and State of Florida's annual retraining / certification requirements. Reserve and Auxiliary personnel are required to volunteer a minimum of 16 hours per month. They perform a variety of functions for our Department and community which are outlined in the chart below. Particularly they assist full-time personnel at community events or special duty functions (requests for an officer to be assigned and compensated by the outside vendor) and during significant weather events such as hurricanes or flooding. Reserve and Auxiliary Officers provide an additional uniformed police presence in neighborhoods, commercial areas, schools, parks, and beaches. Once a month Reserve and Auxiliary Officers have a staff meeting to review policy changes, attend training and address planning and logistical requirements. The below chart signifies the logged hours that have been devoted to the particular assignment by the Reserve and Auxiliary Officers.

## Detective Bureau Monthly Report

October 2020

### INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

#### Self-Initiated Reports:

**Grand Theft** – Victim reported that two suspects stole his cooler filled with fish.

**Hit and Run Crash** – An Homeowners Association (HOA) reported that a driver crashed into one of their light poles. After an investigation, it was found to be one of the homeowners within the HOA. The HOA decided to decline prosecution and handle the matter internally.

**Missing Person** – An adult male with a known drug addiction was reported missing. A follow-up investigation lead to the finding of the adult male and he received the proper treatment.

**Assist other Agency** – An outside State agency requested the Marco Island Police Department interview a subject living on Marco Island in reference to a sex crime.

#### Cases Closed by Detective Bureau

**Hit and Run** – A driver hit a tree and left the scene. The Detective Bureau worked with Patrol and developed a warrant request for the State Attorney's Office.

**Fraud** – A Marco Island business had one of their checks intercepted, modified, and then deposited into an unknown bank account. A follow-up investigation revealed that the check was deposited in Dade County. The case was forwarded to the respective Dade County jurisdiction.

**Burglary** – In July of 2020, MIPD located blood on the scene of a burglary. The blood was sent to FDLE and a match was found for the suspect's DNA profile. The suspect was arrested and is awaiting trial.

**Death Investigation** – A death from July of 2020 was ruled natural causes. Case Closed

**Rental Fraud** – New information caused the re-opening of a prior rental fraud case due to a new witness. The witness was interviewed by local and federal authorities and the case was closed inactive.

**Burglary** – An incident from August of 2020. All credible evidence and leads were pursued, and no suspect was identified. Case Inactive

**Sex Crime** – An allegation of sexual battery was fully investigated, a suspect was identified, and the case was forwarded to the State Attorney's Office.

#### Follow-Up Reports from Patrol:

**Fraud** – The victim reported that an unknown person stole credit cards out of her purse. It was discovered that the suspects used the cards at various locations on Marco Island. Case Active.

**Fraud** – The victim reported that a customer used a stolen credit card at his place of work. A suspect was developed, and the case is ongoing. Case Active

**Possession of IDs/Fraud** – a patrol call for service led to the discovery of narcotics and stolen IDs. Suspect arrested and investigation is still ongoing.

**Risk Protection Order** – The Detective Bureau is currently following up with a Risk Protection Order.

**Harassment** – Detective Bureau assisted in a prior condo management dispute reported to Patrol and documented the incident for future reference. Case Closed

**DV Battery** – Further investigation conducted on a prior reported Domestic Violence from September of 2020. Case forwarded to the State Attorney’s Office with a capias warrant request. State Attorney declined to prosecute.

**Burglary Conveyance** – A report of a burglary and theft of jewelry. Victim returned home and discovered the missing jewelry inside her suitcase. Case Unfounded.
