Legislative Issues

Due to a lack of legal overnight parking options for visiting families and friends during the holiday season, on November 14, 2016 City Council voted in favor of a temporary moratorium on the enforcement of vehicles blocking the sidewalk (Sec.50-37,1c). A Resolution to extend the parking moratorium until January 2, 2017 will be introduced at the December 5, 2016 City Council Meeting.

Beach Patrol

In October, there were 110 unique events attended by Marco Island Police or Community Service Officers. These events included 2 animal complaints and 107 Police or Community Officer initiated patrols on the beach or water immediately adjacent to the beach. For clarity, Officer initiated patrols are events whereby Officers proactively patrol the beach. They are not dispatched calls, nor are there actions or events universally associated with each patrol. During the last City Council Meeting, we were requested to provide additional data regarding beach activities. We have asked staff to report these details when available. As reports are presented to the City Manager and City Council one month behind actual date, the additional details requested will not start appearing in our reports for one additional month. Time dedicated to beach related activities: 181 Hours.

Community Service Officers / Code Enforcement

Sidewalk Violation Update:

In response to a complaint, the following locations are being addressed (education & enforcement) in regards to sidewalk violations – specifically no sidewalk:

- 1000 N. Barfield Drive
- 951 Windward Drive
- 801, 805, 811, 861, 871, 880 & 891 E. Elkcam Circle

Additionally, a second complaint (post injury) was brought to light regarding the sidewalks in the area of Angler's Cove & Rose Marina. A review of the sidewalk panels on the Bald Eagle side of Angler's Cove suggests

that approximately 70% of the panels have some defect and must be replaced. Rose Marina has several areas with non-compliant sidewalk materials (blacktop) and several defective panels as well.

We are making you aware of these issues based on the scope of the problem and the cost to the individual property owners.

In October, the Department's one full-time and eleven part-time CSO's attended to 313 CAD events classified as "Code Complaints" at 288 unique addresses. CAD events at repeat addresses included follow-up investigations.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, EXTENDING A TEMPORARY
MORATORIUM ON THE ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING
REGULATIONS FOR VEHICLES BLOCKING THE
SIDEWALK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, due to the lack of legal overnight parking options for visiting families and friends during the Holiday Season, City Council on November 14, 2016 voted in favor of a temporary moratorium on the enforcement of vehicles blocking a public sidewalk within the City of Marco Island overnight between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the current temporary moratorium approved by City Council expires on December 5, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Marco Island Police Chief recommends that the temporary moratorium be extended through the Christmas, Hanukkah and New Year's holidays (January 2, 2017) without limitations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The Marco Island City Council approves the extension of the temporary moratorium on the enforcement of parking regulations for vehicles blocking a public sidewalk within the City of Marco Island through and including January 2, 2017.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
