During the Memorial Day weekend, the Department increased its Marine Patrols using our Police boat and PWC. ## Beach Patrol

In April, there were 82 unique events that included 1 intoxicated person and 80 Police or Community Service Officer initiated patrols on the beach or water immediately adjacent to the beach. Dedicated beach activities accounted for 125 staff hours during the month.

## Community Service Officers / Code Enforcement

The Department's Community Service Officers conducted proactive patrols of schools, commercial and residential areas, as well as several community events and intermittent beach & parks patrols. Community Service and Law Enforcement personnel attended to 255 CAD (Dispatched) events classified as "Code Complaints" at 229 unique addresses. It is important to note that these calls do not include parking or noise related events which are classified as separate categories. In the last six months of 2015, code violation calls averaged approximately 220 events per month and represented numerically, the single largest category of dispatched versus solely self-initiated calls.

## **Code Compliance Issues:**

### Seawall Staging Permits

A contractor complained that he did not need a staging permit if he was constructing a seawall on a vacant lot. According to the City Attorney, “The adopting ordinance (Ordinance No 13-03) clearly requires a building permit and a temporary use permit for the temporary use of a vacant lot for seawall manufacture, construction, repair and related boat dock construction activities. Section 30-793, City Code of Ordinances. Section 30-793 (3) (c) states that the contractor shall post the subject property with a permit board and all applicable permits including a copy of the temporary use permit.” Community Service Officer / Code Enforcement personnel are administering the ordinances in accordance with the philosophy of strict construction concurrent with the interpretation of the City Attorney. If the contractor’s position is allowed to continue, the absence of a one-to-one relationship between staging and construction permits renders enforcement ineffective. City Council and Waterways Committee may consider a review of seawall staging activities on vacant residential lots and/or amending the ordinance language and policies.

## Landscaping Buffer Activities

Community Service Officers continue to review all locations identified by the Beautification Committee. Process challenges include the fact that nearly every business contacted claims an exemption or “Grandfather” status, while some have requested a “waiver.” While we are providing educational information, legally we must clarify these issues prior to taking any formal enforcement action. We continue to conduct intensive collaborative reviews (\*) in conjunction with the Collier County Property Appraiser as well as the City of Marco Island Planning / Zoning & Building Departments. To do this, we must identify dates & conditions associated with ownership, change of use, prior code enforcement cases or orders, certification of occupancy or other permit conditions. This includes reviewing documents from 1998 to present. Of note, most businesses contacted require intensive assistance as they do not understand the requirements; we have utilized the services of the City’s Environmentalist as well as colleagues from the City of Marco Island Planning / Zoning.
