Reserve / Auxiliary Program Activity Hours

Reserve and Auxiliary Police Officers are unpaid volunteers who are certified by the State of Florida to perform in the law enforcement role. These officers must meet the Department's and State of Florida's annual retraining / certification requirements. Reserve and Auxiliary personnel are required to volunteer a minimum of 16 hours per month. They perform a variety of functions for our Department and community which are outlined in the chart below. Particularly they assist full-time personnel at community events or special duty functions (requests for an officer to be assigned and compensated by the outside vendor) and during significant weather events such as hurricanes or flooding. Reserve and Auxiliary Officers provide an additional uniformed police presence in neighborhoods, commercial areas, schools, parks, and beaches. Once a month Reserve and Auxiliary Officers have a staff meeting to review policy changes, attend training and address planning and logistical requirements. The below chart signifies the logged hours that have been devoted to the particular assignment by the Reserve and Auxiliary Officers.

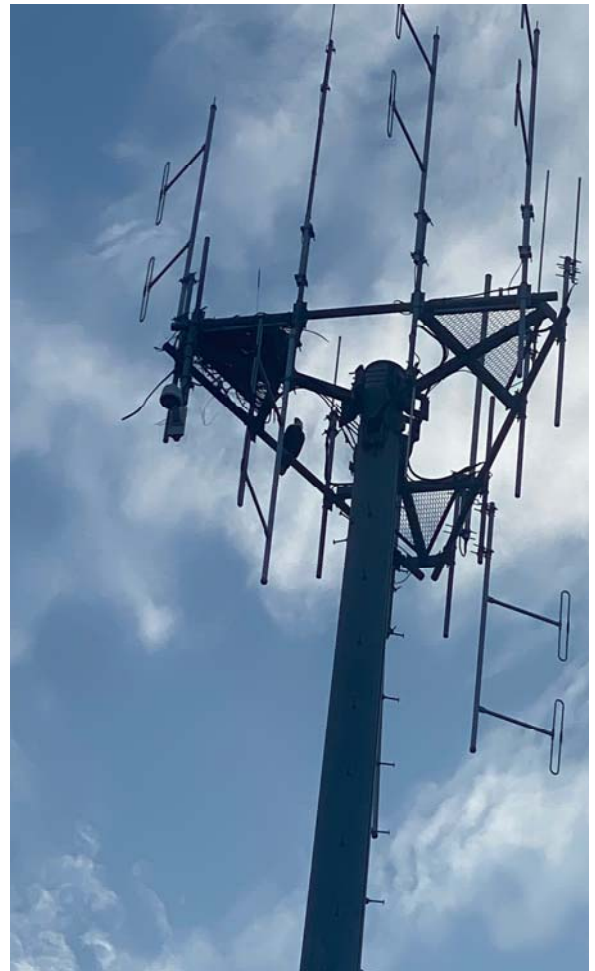

**Detective Bureau Monthly Report
September 2020**

INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

Self-Initiated Reports:

Possession of Cocaine – A traffic stop was conducted in relation to a follow-up on a Fraud / Grand Theft. During the course of this encounter, a suspect was found to be in possession of methamphetamine and arrested.

Harassment – A report was taken to document threats and harassment occurring on social media. Documentation only as prosecution was not desired.

Cases Closed by Detective Bureau

Traffic Crash – A traffic crash involving a pedestrian infant was found to be an accident with no criminal aspect. Case Cleared.

Petit Theft - A follow-up investigation commenced for a stolen bicycle, however the victim desired not to prosecute. Case Cleared.

Sexual Battery – A 15-year-old female was reported pregnant. A follow-up investigation lead to two arrest warrant requests for the female's boyfriend and her father. Warrant request sent to SAO.

Stolen Vehicle – A reported stolen vehicle out of Marco Island was recovered. No leads on the suspect. Case Inactive.

Felony Criminal Mischief – Report of suspects destroying a guard gate to trespass on private property. A follow-up investigation lead to the identification of the two suspects. As arrest warrant requests were being prepped, the victim decided to waive prosecution. Case Cleared.

Felony Trespass – Trespassing at a construction site. Fingerprints were lifted and submitted to CCSO Forensics. The fingerprints did not develop a suspect. Case Inactive

Identity Theft – A report of an identity theft was reviewed, and no suspect(s) could be determined. Case Inactive

Death Investigation – An open investigation was closed as the medical examiner ruled the death to be from natural causes. Case closed.

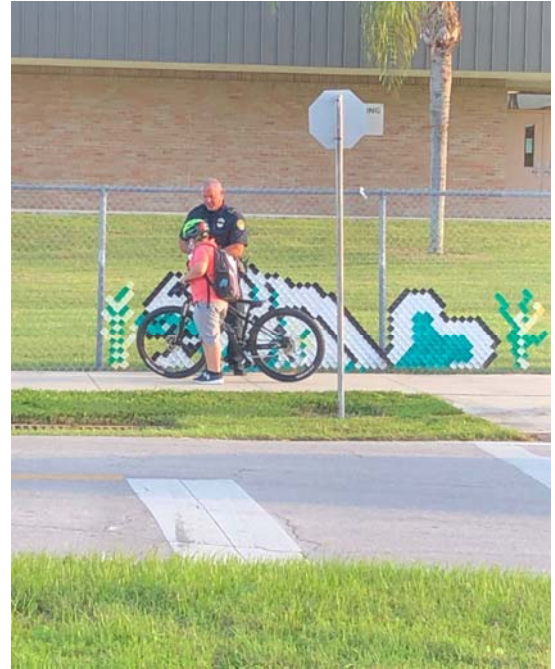

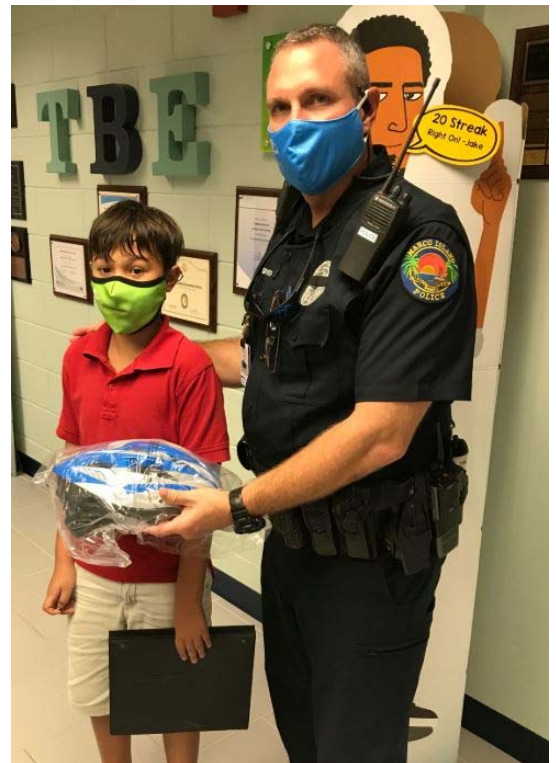

- Confirmed activity at the Madeira Condo had the proper permits and alerted the City Environmentalist as to the activity.

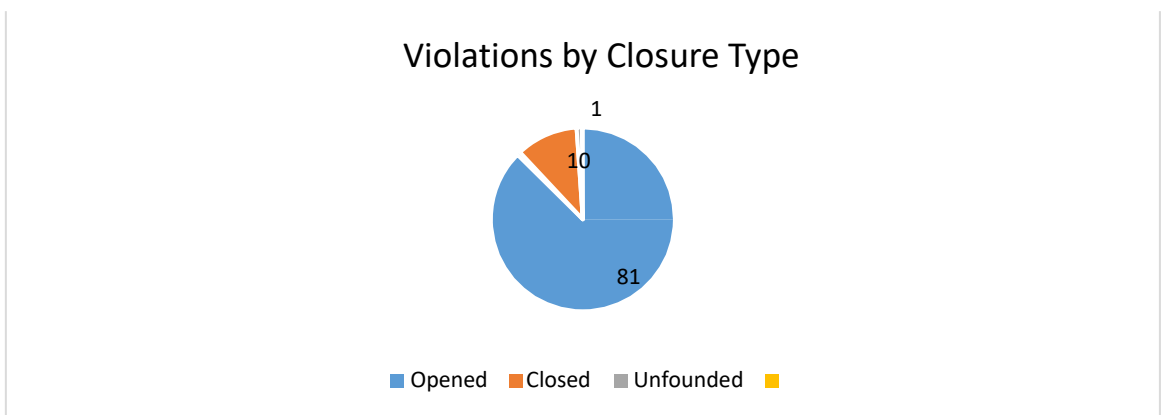
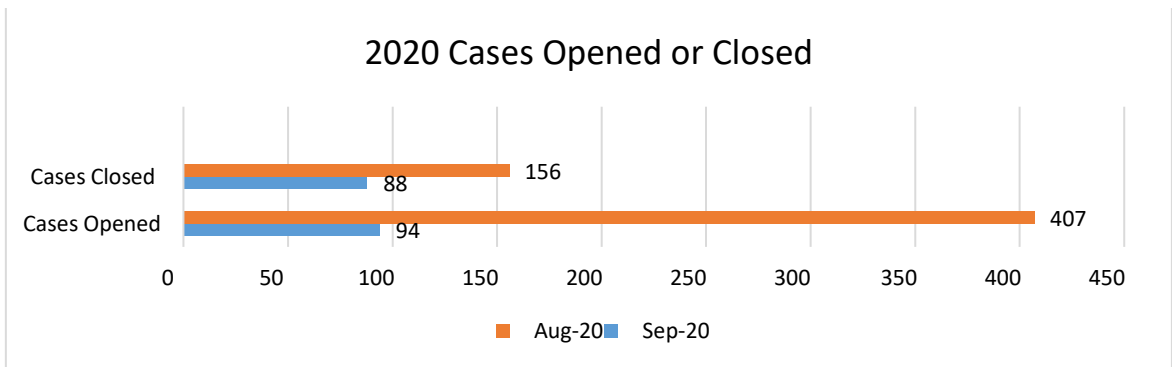
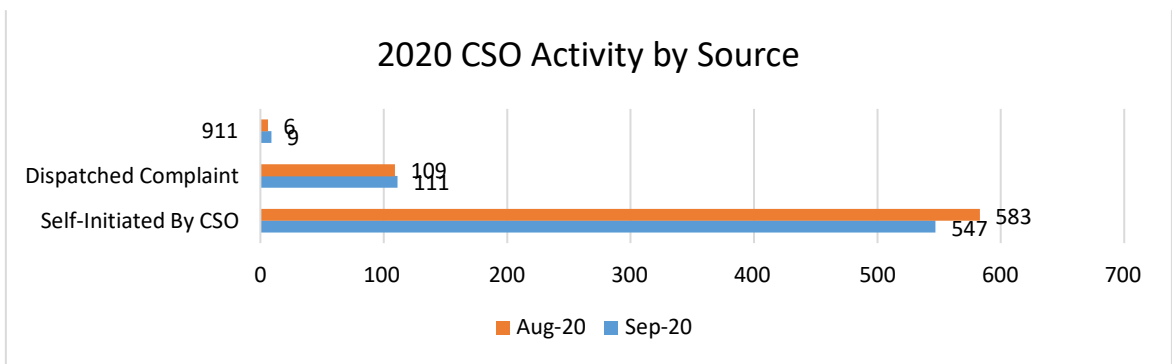
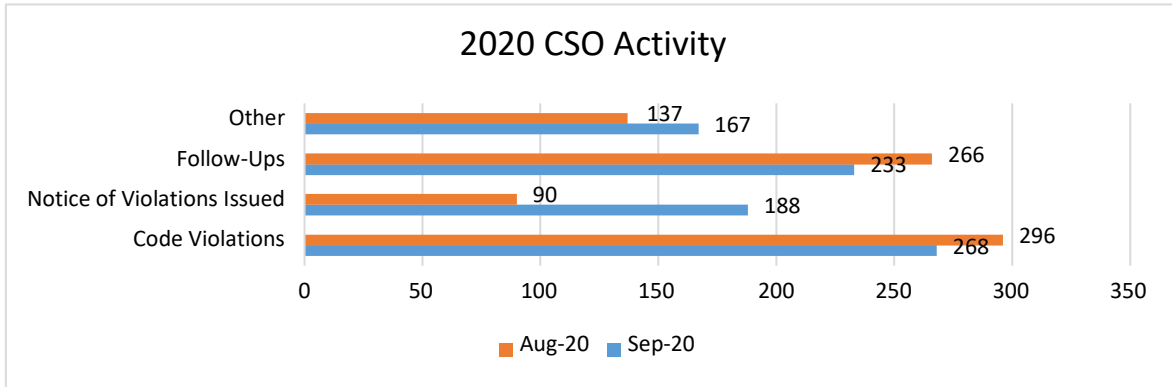
