Re: September 2016 Monthly City Council Report

The Department continues to collaborate with Transformational Strategies & Solutions to develop an up-to-date Policies & Procedures Manual. Modern law enforcement agencies need effective policies and procedures that reflect best practices in the field, legislative changes, protection against litigation, and increased community expectations of ethical and constitutional policing. We anticipate completion of this project in Spring 2017.

The new Policies & Procedures Manual will reflect current industry best practices, legal requirements and current Florida Standards. Also, an up-to-date Policies & Procedures Manual is necessary in order to obtain accreditation from the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement.

The Department is currently researching a new records management system to replace our antiquated NetRMS software. Partnering with the Collier County Sheriff's Office and/or the Naples Police Department is being explored, which would ultimately lead to a cost savings for the City of Marco Island.

The Department will be deploying 4 new patrol vehicles, 2 investigative / administrative, and 2 CSO vehicles by the end of November. Again, these vehicles were scheduled purchases utilizing the funds from the capital replacement program. A similar number of high-mileage / high-maintenance vehicles will be retired.

Finally, on the subject of the capital replacement plan, we will be moving forward with the purchase of four vehicles, thirteen 800 MHz radios, and other scheduled items in FY17.

We will be increasing the frequency of Magistrate Hearings to ensure timely resolution of Code Compliance cases.



The Marco Island Police Department continues to make community outreach activities a priority. Two “Coffee with the Chiefs” events were held on September 30 and October 27 at the Marco Island Starbucks. A “Brunch with the Chiefs” event was held on October 20 at the Marco Island Country Club.

In addition, the always well-attended “Lunch with the Police Chief” event was held at the Hideaway Beach Club on October 18. Chief Schettino’s goal in hosting these public forums is to connect with the community in order to identify, prioritize and

solve local problems, including safety, crime and quality of life issues.

Update on Officer Mark Haueter: Mark underwent major surgery at the Moffitt Cancer Center in Tampa on Tuesday, October 25. The surgeons were successful in removing all the cancer. Mark subsequently underwent extensive reconstructive surgery. His condition continues to improve and his doctors are pleased with the progress of his recovery thus far. He is currently recuperating at his home on Marco Island.

The Department's one full-time and eleven part-time CSO's conducted community patrols of the beach, parks, schools, and commercial and residential areas. They assisted Law Enforcement personnel, conducted fingerprinting on Tuesdays and Thursdays, oversaw the issuance of RV parking permits, and conducted sea turtle / light inspections and beach law education. In September, Community Service and Law Enforcement personnel attended to 235 CAD events classified as "Code Complaints" at 218 unique addresses.
